The exhibition commenced with the recitation of Surah Al-Fatihah and Doa Selamat by Ustaz Haji Mohd Firdaus bin OKK Haji Nordin, followed by a welcoming remark by Fatin Hanani Hamdani, the chairperson of the exhibition.

“This module aims at advancing students’ practical skills in photography and it is not just about taking photos but also to enable the students to do all aspects of photography which includes planning, editing and critically evaluating photographs using theoretical frameworks and lastly to produce professional images,” said Fatin Hanani.

The event then continued with the launching by the guest of honour and who also viewed the exhibition and participated in a puzzle-game.

Speaking to the Bulletin, David Cheok said, “It is a more advance module that carries from previous modules. Hence in order to get in, the students from the previous modules need to pass a certain grade because the techniques we use and what we taught them were on how to control and create images from both technical and artistic sides.”

Through the exhibition, the students are not only learning about photography, but also learn how to organise an event. To enliven the two-day exhibition, the students also conducted a photo shoot session.

Also in attendance were lecturers of Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS), key members of the UBD senate, the team leader, as well as students.

The exhibition is still ongoing today from 9am to 5pm, and is open to the public.


